

## 2017 Post Season Player Selection:

### Eligibility:

- 1) Player must have played in 60% of regular season games. Medical waivers are possible
- 2) Player must have completed the Eligibility form electronically by the end of day May 15, 2017
- 3) Players will be disqualified if they miss a 4<sup>th</sup> practice or any game before July 12, 2017
- 4) Family must produce proper documentation in a timely manner

### Criteria:

- 1) Selections are based on HOW THE PLAYER PERFORMED THAT SEASON (2017)
- 2) Selection will NOT be based on friendships, play on tournament teams, etc.
- 3) A Player's attitude, sportsmanship, and being a good team teammate may be considered
- 4) Parents behavior will NOT be a factor
- 5) A Player's selection is a REWARD for a great season & being a good member of the local little league community. It is not owed to anyone for Wins or HR's

### Selection Process:

- 1) Majors Managers, Player Agent, President, Vice President, and Division Director will meet to discuss players 2017 performances by *May 21*. Managers will have the opportunity to advocate for their players. It is suggested that they compile some statistics to support their case.
  - HLL Board approved that each D52 All Star team would be composed of 12 or 13 kids (manager's discretion)
    - Kid vote determining 4 players,
    - Manager vote determining 6 players, and
    - All Star Manager discretion to determine the last 2 - 3 players.
    - Final 2 or 3 picks to be approved by the Competition Committee
  - HLL Board approved the Kid Vote ballot to "select exactly 10 players age 12, 7 players age 11, and 4 players age 10."
  - HLL Board approved the Manager Vote ballot to "select exactly 15 players age 12, 10 players age 11, and 4 players age 10."
- 2) Majors paper vote by players will occur on May 20, 2017 at the Majors games scheduled that day. Majors Manager vote will occur after the meeting discussed in point #1 by end of day *May 23, 2017*.
- 3) Votes will be tallied. The 12's and 11's manager and two official coaches will meet with the competition committee to determine the last 2 or 3 players on the team. There can include up to two 11-year-old players on the 12's team and they must be discretionary selections. Meeting should be held before end of day *May 25, 2017*.
- 4) Majors Superbowl – The top eight 12-year-old vote recipients who are not included on the All Star team from the Managers vote will be selected to the team. The remaining four will be selected by the Superbowl Manager subject to the approval of the Competition Committee. Under certain circumstances, an 11-year-old can be considered for one of the discretionary picks.
- 5) 10's All Star team will be composed of 9 and 10-year-old players from both Majors and Minors divisions.

- 6) Minors Managers, Player Agent, President, Vice President, and Division Director will meet to discuss players 2017 performances by *May 21*. Managers will have the opportunity to advocate for their players. It is suggested that they compile some statistics to support their case.
  - HLL Board approved the Minors Manager Vote ballot to “select exactly 15 players” by *May 23, 2017*
- 7) Votes will be tallied. The top four from Majors and the top six from minors (who are eligible) will comprise the first 10 players on the All Star team. The 10’s manager and two official coaches will meet with the competition committee to determine the last 2 or 3 players on the team. Meeting should be held before *May 27, 2017*.
- 8) Minors Superbowl – The top eight Minors vote recipients who are not included on the All Star team from the Managers vote will be selected to the team. The remaining four will be selected by the Superbowl Manager subject to the approval of the Competition Committee.
- 9) In the case where there are not enough players based on eligibility to fill the Manager vote slots, the team manager will have discretion to complete the roster with approval by the Competition Committee.
- 10) All Teams will be announced on June 1.
